

AVAILABLE WINES

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2004 Cabernet Sauvignon Mendocino County \$24/bottle

Grown at the base of Duncan Peak in Hopland, this is a well structured wine with dusty aromas of earth and generous black fruit flavors. The complex, fine coating tannins contribute to a richness that is typical of Cabernet Sauvignon. Aromas and flavors of plum, mint, and blackberry. Extended barrel aging of 28 months allowed this wine to develop and showcase the flavors of Mendocino County fruit.

Winemaker notes:

Certified organically grown grapes. Fermented in small, open top fermenters and punched down three times daily. Aged for 28 months in French oak barrels.

2005 Syrah Sonoma County \$28/bottle

This Syrah comes from a small, hillside vineyard in the Mayacamas hills of Sonoma County and is farmed biodynamically. Fermented with native yeasts, the wine is dark and rich with flavors of berries and aromas of stone fruit, white pepper and earth. A big, California style of syrah with explosive aromatics and a warm, smooth palate.

Winemaker notes: Certified organically grown grapes, biodynamically farmed. Fermented with native yeast in small open top fermenters and punched down three times daily.

Aged 16 mo. in artisan coopered French oak.
Alcohol 15.2%. 322 Cases Made



2006 Chardonnay Harms Vineyard Napa Valley Oak Knoll District \$30/bottle

Planted to Dijon clones on a small hillside in the Oak Knoll district of Napa Valley, this vineyard is lovingly farmed by Donald and Patricia Harms, according to Demeter Certified Biodynamic Standards. Barrel fermented with native yeasts and intentional lees stirring this wine was aged 12 months and bottled unfiltered and unfiltered. Forming delicate aromas of honeyed pear, lime and pineapple, this wine is balanced with a long creamy finish and flavors of hazelnut, fig and apple. A rich wine, golden hued and intense. Complete malolactic fermentation.

Winemaker notes: Certified organically grown grapes. Whole cluster pressed, barrel fermented and aged on the primary lees for 12 months in artisan French oak, sustainably harvested barrels. Weekly lees stirring added varietal complexity and accentuated the generous mouthfeel.

Alcohol 14.5%. 240 Cases made Release Date: Aug. 1, 2008



2006 Pinot Noir Russian River Valley Sonoma County \$40/bottle

Sourced from a 1.5 acre vineyard in the heart of the Russian River Valley. Planted to Dijon and Pommard clones and farmed biodynamically. My personal favorite wine. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered, this Pinot Noir has wonderful aromas and flavors of ripe cherry, rose petal and wild blackberry. Medium tannin structure with bright, natural acidity and layers of spice, toast and tea leaf on the nose. Benefits from aeration.

Winemaker notes: Certified organically grown grapes. Fermented in 1 ton lots with native yeasts and hand punched caps. Aged in 40% new, artisan French oak, sustainably harvested barrels.

Alcohol 14.7%. 93 Cases Made Release Date: Aug. 1, 2008

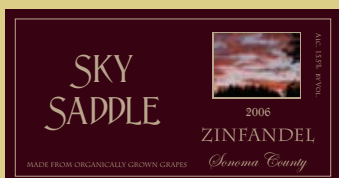


2006 Sangiovese Harms Vineyard Napa Valley Oak Knoll District \$24/bottle

Also from the Harm's vineyard in the Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley. Farmed according to Demeter certified Biodynamic standards. This Sangiovese is dark and lush with bold fruit flavors and aromas of blueberry, nutmeg and black cherry. A fruit driven food wine with excellent natural acidity and complex aromatics. The beautiful color is reminiscent of this ancient and noble Italian varietal.

Winemaker notes: Certified organically grown grapes. Fermented with native yeasts and hand punched caps. Barrel aged for 18 months in mostly neutral French oak barrels to highlight the varietal flavors.

Alcohol 14.5%. 258 Cases Made Release Date: Aug. 1, 2008



2006 Zinfandel Sonoma County \$28/bottle

Biodynamically farmed Sonoma Mtn Hillside select. A powerhouse style Sonoma Zinfandel. Massive black fruit flavors with aromas of dried fruit, berries and spice. This highly extracted wine is hearty and warm with medium tannins and a traditionally rich Zinfandel mouthfeel.

Winemaker notes:

Certified organically grown grapes. Biodynamically farmed. Fermented with native yeast in small, open top fermenters, punched down three times daily.

Aged for 22 months in American and French oak barrels. 25% new oak

Alcohol 15.5% 150 Cases Made
